"A lot of the design work evolves on site," he said. "Not on paper like most designers – I do not design in a vacuum. My design develops interactively with the client."

While heritage work, including projects like the painstaking rebuild of the Rochon House porch based on a 1908 photo, is satisfying and rewarding, most of Denys' time is spent on functional yet appealing kitchen, bathroom and family area projects, with project value and scope ranging from \$20,000 to \$100,000 or more.

Denys says his biggest strength is his ability to help clients make their own decisions, by listening to their wishes and then suggesting ideas. "My role as a designer/builder is not to tell my clients what to do, but to give them the choices and make them aware of the options."

For example, he listens to how long the clients expect to stay in their home (these days, it is usually 10 years or less) and then recommends the level of renovation that will satisfy their needs and retain value for the future. Kitchens and bathrooms, of course, are important both because they are immediately functional and because homeowners can quickly recover the cost of the renovation in increased property and resale value.

"Every client is different," he says. "Some wish to be involved in all aspects of the project, going around to showrooms, and selecting fixtures and the like, and others wish me to take care of all the details."

He adds: "Anything difficult and finicky to do – that's what we're known for."

Clients always receive real value for their money. Denys' understanding of design, as well as his extensive reading and research on building issues and trends, ensures that the work is both effective and functional. In fact, he gently discourages inappropriate or excessive renovations where the cost of the work far exceeds the value of building a new structure. "I ask how much value is there in a \$100,000 media room, or a complete home renovation to accommodate space needs for a family with teenagers who will soon leave the house," he says.
